### A broader descriptions of these volunteer positions

Archives Library & Collections Volunteers - Tile Heritage Foundation archives, permanent collections, library and digital resources require hundreds of hours of management and maintenance every year to keep them active, accessible and useful. Volunteers may work in the library, archival files, data bases, digital image collection, photography collection and permanent tile collection storage facility assisting in their management. Volunteers are trained to manage specific tasks and should be willing to commit to volunteering at least two days a month. Volunteers with archiving experience are especially needed.

**Advocacy** - Tile Heritage especially embraces THF members with shared values in the long term mission of the Foundation, engaging and recruiting others to become **members**, **sponsors or volunteers**, playing a significant role in funding current programs. **Volunteers** will be provided pertinent materials and training for this undertaking and should be willing to commit to **volunteering for a specific time period with a beginning and end date.** 

**Grant Writing -** The Foundation has many resources available and is looking for **experienced grant writer volunteers** to assist in grant writing and other funding activities. A Strategic Plan and resources are available to assist volunteers.

**Special Event Volunteers** are often needed for community specific tile sales & workshops as well as soliciting new members for THF at these events. **Volunteers** will be provided pertinent materials and training and should be willing to commit to **volunteering for a specific event.** 

Online or specific site "Auction Support Staff" - Auctions need experienced volunteers with organizing and computer skills or a willingness to learn about running online or site specific auctions as well as asking for and organizing donated materials. Online auctions often have many months of lead time. Volunteers will be provided pertinent materials and training for this type of job and should be willing to commit to volunteering for a specific time period with a beginning and end date.

Clerical support including web and other technology skills - The Foundation is interested in skilled assistance with bookkeeping tasks, filing, data entry and other day to day office tasks. Volunteers are trained to manage specific tasks and should be willing to commit to volunteering at least two days a month.

Photograph, Digitally Document and Map - Tile Heritage encourages the documentation and mapping of tile and mosaic and other ceramic surfacing materials (facia) on the exterior and interior of buildings and other locations accessible to the public. Volunteers willing to work on this type of documentation should also be willing to share their findings with the Foundation and make their findings available for publication. There is no time limit but a specific commitment to engage in such a project is appreciated to allow Tile Heritage staff to support you in your efforts.

Community Build Projects - Volunteer to participate in a tile or mosaic community enhancement project or installation. Volunteers should be experienced in installation or willing to learn, able to teach others or willing to participate in securing funding and/or materials for a project in their own or other communities. Volunteers will be provided pertinent materials and training for this type of job and should be willing to commit to volunteering for a specific time period with a beginning and end date.

**Help clean or restore** a public installation faced with tiles, terra cotta or mosaic. Site specific calls for assistance are made to Tile Heritage from time to time. **Volunteers** with skills and interest in such undertakings should contact Tile Heritage to link to projects.
